

NURHC 09 Photo Competition

The NRHSN is always on the lookout for photos to use in publications, newsletter, website, posters and more to promote rural and remote health to members and all health students across Australia. At NURHC we will be holding a competition that will be judged by delegates with excellent prizes, giving you the opportunity to display your photo and possibly see it in future publications.

The NRHSN Executive and NURHC Co-Convenors will assess all photos and come up with a top 20 for delegates to vote on. So in order to do this, here are a few guidelines:

- All photos must be forwarded in **electronic format** to the NRHSN by **1 June 2009**
This can be via email to kerryn@nrhsn.org.au or post to NRHSN, Level 6, 10 Queens Rd, Melbourne VIC 3004
Please note that the higher the quality (megapixels, image size) the better from our perspective, in terms of printing, particularly if selected for publications
- Make sure that each photo that is sent in includes the following details
 - Photographers name and contact details (email and contact phone number)
 - A 1-2 sentence explaining what the photo is and the story behind it
- The top 20 photos selected by the NURHC committee will then be printed and displayed at NURHC in a set format, displayed throughout the conference and voted on by delegates
- The winner will be announced at the NURHC Formal Dinner with prizes awarded for the top 3
- There is no limitation on what your photo can be, we would love a variety of rural, remote, health, university, rural health club activities... anything that you think might help inspire other health students to consider rural placements or rural practice
- By submitting photos to the competition you agree to allow the NRHSN to use them in future publications (please ensure that you have consent for photos in which you have photographed people/where consent is required)
- You are able to enter as many photos as you would like, and do not need to be attending NURHC to enter
